Great mountain biking, but also good road riding in the Idyllwild area.

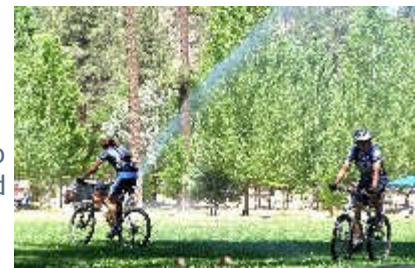
Or just come up for the picnic.
